




Reducing your environmental footprint: recycled jigsaw

Instructions

What you will need checklist:

- Piece of recycled cardboard
- Coloring pens or paints to create your picture
- Scissors
- A recycled box to store your jigsaw in

Instructions:

- 1. Get a piece of recycled cardboard
- 2. Draw a picture, or print one and attach it to the cardboard
- 3. Turn the cardboard over and draw a jigsaw design. You could get creative with your jigsaw design
- 4. Cut out your jigsaw pieces you may need to ask an adult to help you.
- 5. Complete your jigsaw
- 6. Why not design a box for your jigsaw too?
