
Interested in hosting a Green Tea at your home but not sure what you're getting yourself into? Find out exactly what's involved in being a Green Tea host right here:





A "Green Tea" is a fun and engaging home party where you and your guests learn simple, practical and affordable ways to maintain a greener household and how to:

- Gathering a group of 4-6 people (including yourself) committed to attending the party
- Working with your Green Calgary facilitator to send a preparation email to your guests with pre-party activities
- Providing a home Wi-Fi password the day of the party (guests work on tablets to complete a personalized "Green Tea Survey")
- Committing one of your home's bathrooms to a water saving demonstration (all products supplied) including:
 - checking a toilet for a leak
 - changing a faucet aerator to a water saving one
 - changing a showerhead to a water saving one
- Providing kitchen space for the demonstration of a homemade natural cleaner
- Working with your Green Calgary facilitator to send a post-event follow-up email to your guests.
